On the traces of the beer



1st day: Arrival in Munich

Welcome by our team at the airport in Munich and transfer by bus to the center of Munich. We will pass by the main attractions of the town and will arrive at the famous brewery and restaurant “Hofbräuhaus”. With a strong lunch we will get our first type of beer, a “Helles”(light lager). *This beer is made of dark barley and low content of hop in an bottom fermentation process.* Afterwards we will have a walk in the center of Munich.

2nd day: Munich

Subject of our journey is the beer. We will get a first explanation of the production of the various types of beer in the brewery of “Franziskaner”. Afterwards we will have a walk in the biggest garden of Munich, the “English Garden”. *Here we will encounter a special form of cooling of the past. In order to get the utmost shadow in the summertime the breweries planted trees above their beer cellar. This is the origin of the “Biergarten” (beer garden).* We will take the opportunity to taste a “Weizen”, the most famous top fermented beer of Southern Germany, based on wheat instead of barley, in such a beer garden.

3rd day: Czech beer

A history of beer without Bohemian beer and Pilsner is incomplete. The brewery of “Pilsener Urquell” in Pilsen will give us the opportunity to learn more about this type of beer created here and to taste it during lunch. We will arrive in Prague in the afternoon.

4th day: Prague

In Prague, the golden town, we will visit the castle with the cathedral of St. Vitus on the hill “Hradschin”, the symbol of the town, the famous Charles Bridge and the down town historical center.

5th day: Dresden

After breakfast we will continue our journey towards the famous baroque city of Dresden by bus. After lunch (with black beer) we will walk through the splendid old town with the baroque buildings like the palace “Zwinger”, the opera of Semper, the cathedral, Bruehl’s terrace and the renaissance buildings like the residence. The original beer of Dresden is a Pils of the brewery „Radeberger“.

6th day: Berlin

In the morning we will visit the famous isle of museums. The museum of Pergamon exhibits the altar of Pergamon, a reconstruction of the gates of Babylon and a lot more of the ancient cultures. We will have the chance to see the sculpture of Nefertiti in the new museum. After so much culture of the past we will come back to the reality with a “Berliner Weiße mit Schuss”, a top fermented light beer with a little portion of lemonade. In the afternoon we will visit the town by with stops at the attractions of the town, like the Brandenburg Gate, the parliament, the avenue “Kurfürstendamm”, Checkpoint Charlie or the central place “Gendarmenmarkt”.

7th day: Berliner Kindl

The brewery „Berliner Kindl“ offers insights of the production of beer type Pilsen during a guided tour. Potsdam with the famous palace “Sanssouci” of Friedrich the Great will be our next station.

8th day: Bremen

The historical center of Bremen with the famous town hall, the cathedral St. Petri and the statue of the Roland, together honored as World Heritage, will be our first step of the day. The visit of the quarters “Schnoor” and





“Schlachte” as well as the street “Böttcherstraße” will complete our impression of this town and its history. Dinner in Bremen should include the Beck’s beer from Bremen.

9th day: Arrival in the Netherlands
Osnabruck, the town of the Peace of Westphalia, which ended the Thirty Years' War, is a stopover on our way to the Netherlands.

10th day: Heineken
“Heineken” is the best known beer of the Netherlands. We will visit the exposition of this company in the “Heineken Experience” Center. A tour by bus will bring us to the highlights of Amsterdam in the afternoon.

11th day: Amsterdam
A walk through the center of Amsterdam will take the whole morning. Amsterdam is famous for its channels (Grachten). A boat tour through those channels is planned for the afternoon.

12th day: Brussels
Brussels is the capital of Belgium and the main headquarters of the European Union. We will travel to Brussels in the morning and will visit the museum of the brewery Cantillon in the afternoon. *Cantillon is the producer of the famous “Gueuze” beer, a double brewed beer of two different charges of beer.*

13th day: Belgium
Belgium is a small country and we will visit the main cities like Bruges and Antwerpen in one day. This day will end in the “Délirium Café” in Brussels, famous for over 2000 different beers.

14th: Düsseldorf
“Altbier” is a dark top fermented lager beer, created in Düsseldorf. We will taste it during a “Altbier Safari”.

15th day: Cologne
“Kölsch” is a clear top fermented beer from Cologne. We will check the differences on our last day of the journey, after visiting the famous cathedral and the center of Cologne. Our flight back will start at the airport of Cologne.



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
