



14 days in Germany

We will start our journey in Munich and will drive to the Zugspitze the highest mountain of Germany. The Pre-alps we will visit cruising from Garmisch-Partenkirchen to the Lake Constance where we will reach the Black Forrest. Here we have the next formation of landscape, the highlands, that will accompany us along the river Rhine until Cologne. The landscape gets flatter as we drive to the North of the country

of the country reaching the plains and finally the North Sea. The steady alteration between survival in salty water at high tide and sun at low tide requires a special form of creatures and plants in the Wadded Sea. This biotope of the North Sea is protected as a National Park and honored as World Heritage by the UNESCO. After visiting the Baltic Sea and the National Park of Jasmund the journey will end in Berlin, the lively Capital of Germany as counter point to the landscapes.
