



11 days in northern Germany

We will start our journey in **Frankfurt** having a wine tasting in the Abbey of Eberbach. After Frankfurt we will go by ship to Koblenz passing the world heritage of **Upper Middle Rhine** with its castles and vineyards. From here we will arrive in **Cologne** our first city of the *Hanseatic League* of the Middle Ages. We will continue with the cities at the North Sea **Bremen and Hamburg** and afterward with the cities at the Baltic Sea **Lübeck, Wismar und Stralsund**, cities recognized by the UNESCO as
